1	Apologies for Absence Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Readman, Mrs J Brown and County Councillor Mrs H Moorhouse.
2	Declaration of Interest in items on the Agenda Declarations declared and noted with the relevant topic/s.
3	Members of the Public invited to address the Council PCSO Ellington presented the Police report. There had been a total of 6 incidents reported between 6 June and 4 July 2017. The Police were still in discussions with the Community Safety Partnership regarding the temporary CCTV camera to be installed in the arcade. It was noted that there had been a significant decrease in the number of incidents this month and this could be because of the increased patrols now that the Stokesley Team was back up to full strength. Noted. A resident from Skottowe Drive attended to complain about the overgrown shrubs surrounding her property. The Clerk would report this to Highways who were responsible for the maintenance of this area. Agreed.
4	Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on Tuesday 6 June 2017 The minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on Tuesday 6 June 2017 were approved and signed. Agreed.
5	Police Report The Police Report had been received and circulated and presented under the public session. Noted.
6	Council Services Report Cemetery The Clerk had contacted the Vicar regarding the consecration of the Cemetery land. The Vicar had confirmed that he would discuss this with the Bishop. Noted. Captain Cook Garden – it was agreed to progress the removal of the tree as soon as possible. Cllr Mrs Taylor would ask if the volunteers would be interested in maintaining the garden. Agreed. Flower Tubs – the volunteers have kindly planted the tubs on the entrance signs to the Village but they require strimming so they are visible. The Clerk would ask the Cemetery Superintendent to do this. Agreed.

Public Conveniences - It was agreed to try and obtain a specification and costs for refurbishing the toilets so that members could consider whether to include this scheme in the budget next year as well as seeing if they could secure S106 funds towards it. Cllrs Fletcher and Taylor would draw up a specification with a view to then obtaining quotes. It was confirmed that the cistern in the ladies toilet had been replaced with a more robust unit. **Agreed.**

Alloments – the Clerk advised that several gardens were in a poor state and required strimming and spraying. The Cemetery Superintendent would be asked if he had time to carry out this work. **Agreed.**

7 Planning Applications

All Councillors present declared an interest in planning application 17/01158/FUL & LBC and 17/01270/CAT. Cllr Fletcher also declared an interest in planning application 17/01269/TPO.

The Clerk was asked to write to HDC expressing our concerns regarding the current planning process in particular the lack of documentation sent for us to consider as this does not enable us to make an informed observation. The fact that little or notice seems to be taken of the comments made from the Parish Council, recent examples include request for a detailed tree report which was not received and approval was just granted. Decision are made without taking into account local knowledge and also the length of time taken regarding planning decisions. **Agreed.**
